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


OUR CARE MODEL








GROWTH IN SERVICES







ADULTS & FAMILIES

With a proactive approach to screening for, preventing, and managing illness, patients of TVHC are supported in every stage of life knowing their providers are working hard to provide the best care in every visit.

WOMEN'S HEALTH

Comprehensive reproductive health services are provided on-site at TVHC, including gynecology, preventive health exams, prenatal and postpartum care. TVHC partners with local labor and delivery providers and high-risk pregnancy specialists to ensure smooth and coordinated transitions for our pregnant patients.

PEDIATRICS

Our pediatric providers ensure families and children are offered culturally-competent, age-appropriate care to foster healthy growing and stay equipped with the healthcare and social services they need.

INNOVATION

Team-Based Care

Over the past few years, TVHC has implemented Care Teams, an integrated, whole-person approach to health care. Each Care Team includes a dedicated Primary Care Provider (PCP), a Medical Assistant, and specially trained staff working together to identify and address both clinical and social service needs, ensuring no patients fall through the cracks.

Leveraging Telehealth

With the addition of phone and video visits, TVHC is advancing a flexible, patient-centered telehealth model to improve access, reduce delays, and support efficiency.





OPTOMETRY

Nationwide, less than 3% of community health center patients receive eye and vision care services. TVHC is proud to exceed this average, with 21% of our adult and pediatric patients receiving optometry services.

PODIATRY

TVHC's podiatrist diagnoses and treats a wide range of foot, ankle, and lower limb conditions to keep patients healthy. She works closely with patients' primary care teams to provide preventative care for diabetic patients and mitigate complications.

DENTAL

TVHC's dental department offers a variety of dental services for children and adults using state-of-the-art offices and equipment, including comprehensive exams, fillings, extractions, and emergency services.

In 2025, TVHC introduced its new Mobile Dental Clinic, thanks to the generous support of the Delta Dental Community Care Foundation, complete with operatories, imaging equipment, a patient waiting area, and more.

The mobile clinic arrived at a pivotal time, just months after flooding forced the closure of TVHC's largest dental department. Thanks to the mobile dental clinic, TVHC continued serving dental patients in need and is better equipped to respond swiftly to future emergencies.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

TVHC's Integrated Behavioral Health department provides a collaborative, whole-person approach to behavioral health within primary care. The program offers a continuum of care, from prevention and early intervention to therapy, care coordination, ensuring patients receive seamless support wherever they are in their wellness journey.

30,000 services provided

TVHC's Cultura y Bienestar team organizes community events, educational workshops, outreach and traditional healing events, as well as providing early interventions and referral sessions.

Participants in the program reported significant mental health improvements, including reduced anxiety and depression, feeling less isolated, and increased cultural connection and resilience.

"A friend told me about a weekly group for seniors, so I decided to go one day. I was going through a hard time—homeless, in a lot of pain from a bad tooth, and feeling really down.

After the group, I talked to the facilitator. She listened to me and helped connect me to someone at the clinic. They got me in with a dentist, helped me with my high blood pressure and sugar, and even gave me housing support. I still go to the group every week. Talking, laughing, being heard—it helps. I'm very grateful."

STREET MEDICINE

TVHC's Street Health team provides medical, behavioral health, triage, care management, and housing support for unhoused individuals.





356 unhoused patients

To meet the needs of this underserved population, the Street Health program uses mobile vans to provide on-the-spot care and social services to patients, in addition to transporting patients for more complex care. The team also distributes Naloxone and implements other harm reduction activities to protect these individuals.





SCHOOL CLINICS

TVHC operates five school-based health centers within the county, providing on-site services for students and community members. This includes exams, sports physicals, immunizations, prescriptions, reproductive health services, and referrals for dental and behavioral health services.

"Staying Healthy" assessments are carried out across the Youth Health Services program, which seek to identify and support students with mental and physical health needs specific to their stage of life, such as anxiety and other screening and reproductive health needs.

COMMUNITY EVENTS

The Community Outreach and Advocacy (COA) team conducts culturally and linguistically responsive outreach and education through grocery stores, health fairs, libraries, parks, and food security events.

TVHCs Promotoras de Salud are an extremely important part of this team, volunteering as mentors, health educators, advocates, and agents of change in their communities. Our Promotoras program has been well-established for over 20 years, spreading awareness and combatting healthcare misinformation to ensure community members get the care they need.





ELIGIBILITY & ENROLLMENT

TVHC's Eligibility team acts as many patients' first step on their journeys to receiving health care, helping patients get educated and enrolled for health coverage and support services.

Working across teams and in multiple settings, TVHC's Eligibility team connects with the community where they are and offers on-the-spot preliminary screenings to help them understand the benefits available to them.





EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT

From 2023-2025, TVHC was awarded a grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration to enhance Early Childhood Development (ECD) for children up to age five. Through this grant, TVHC built a team to provide direct support to families and children during this critical development period.

ECD work, like early childhood assessments, connecting families to resources, and ongoing developmental guidance, is now a routine part of patient care to ensure children are thriving.

WIC & NUTRITION

TVHC's WIC program provides access to nutritious foods, information on healthy eating, breastfeeding support, referrals, and other services that support new parents and their families.

Throughout the year, our WIC team meets with parents for consultations, distributes farmers market vouchers, and hosts events for community education and resource awareness to keep new families engaged.

FAMILY SUPPORT

For pregnant and parenting teens and adults, inhome visits and case management support school completion, connection to resources, and progress toward self-sufficiency. Parenting and prenatal support groups, positive parenting education, and fatherhood initiatives are also available.
